This guide will help you to quickly get started taking courses at PoliceCommunity.net.

It walks you step by step through the process of taking your first course. Print it out and keep it by your side as you learn to navigate the Learning Management System.

## About eLearning

PoliceCommunity.net integrates a Learning Management System from our training partner, eLogic Learning, to manage and control the use of all distance learning courses as part of your annual subscription. This LMS provides automated tracking of each student's curriculum and provides regular updates to law enforcement agencies.

## 1. Sign-in

To get started, sign in to PoliceCommunity.net with the user name and password that was emailed to you. To do this, the 'Login' menu item at the home page of PoliceCommunity.net (see below). If this is your first time signing in, PoliceCommunity.net will prompt you to choose a new password.

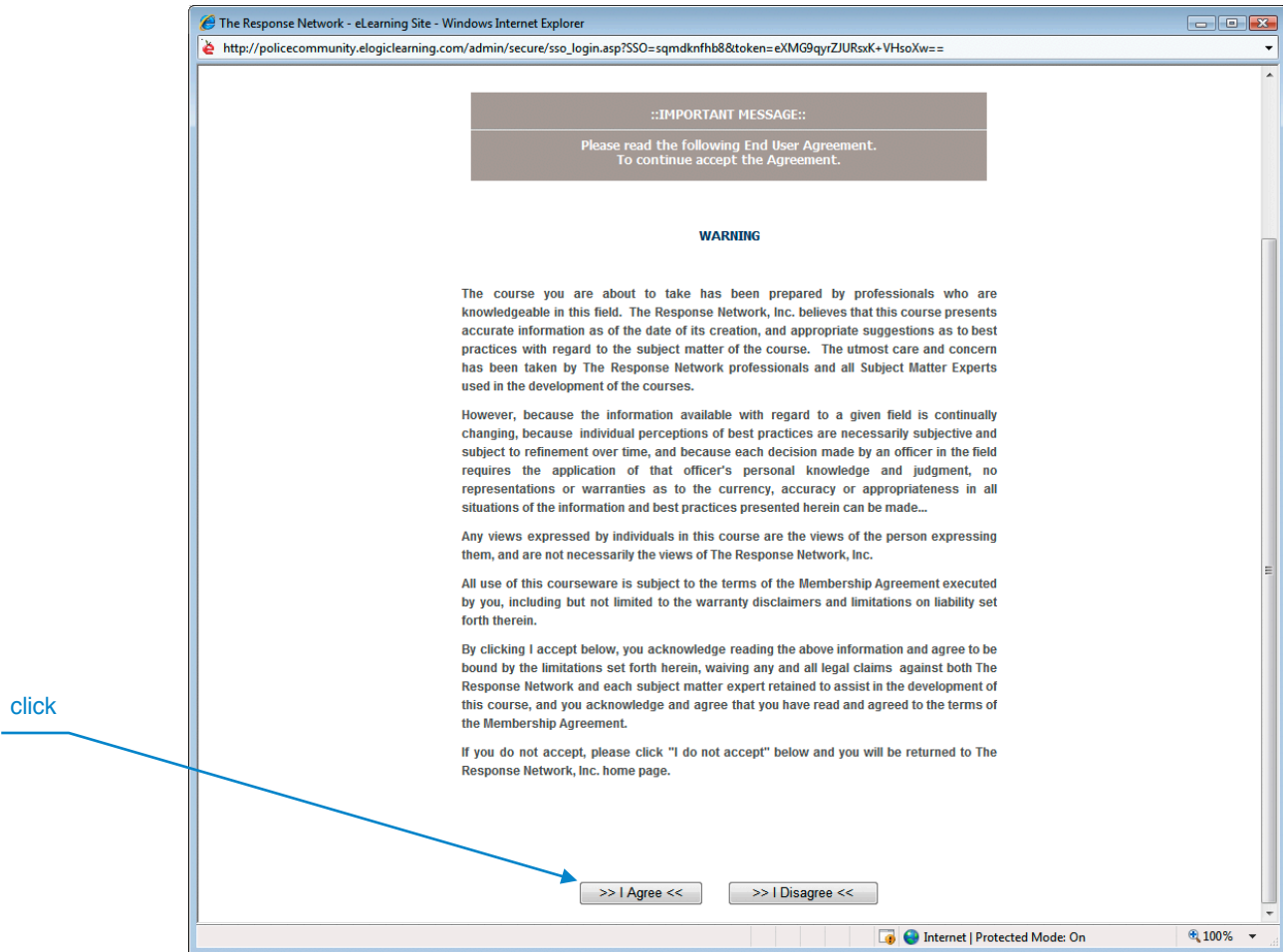

## 4. LMS Homepage

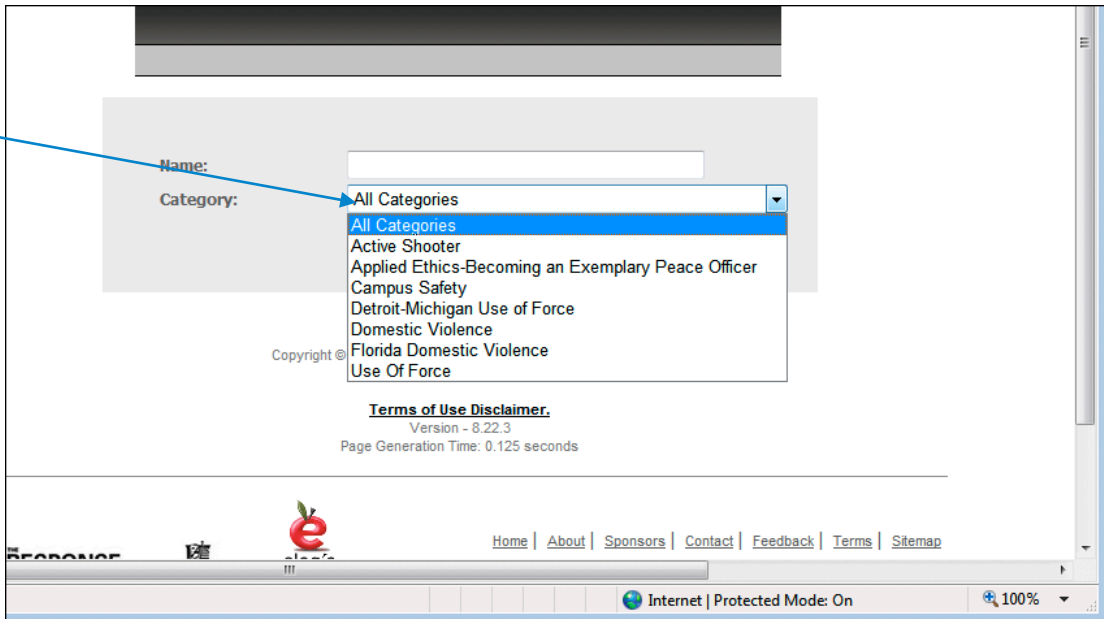
